Affiliation:

The CSASC is part of Swimming North Queensland (SNQ) and our club is registered with SNQ, Swimming Queensland (SQ), and Swimming Australia (SA).

Membership:

All members are asked to abide by all SQ, SA and club rules, which are outlined in this handbook. Financial members are able to participate/compete in all SA events and are covered by SA Insurance.

<u>Membership Fees:</u> Competitive Swimmer 9&O - \$135.00 Recreational Swimmer 9&O - \$105.00 Swimmer 8&U - \$105.00 Our Club Accepts - The Qld Government Fair Play Vouchers for membership fees.

Club Nights Event Fees:

\$1.00 per swim event on club nights \$3.00 per swim for Open Championship events on club nights

Competitive Swimming Carnival's Away Meet Coaching Fees:

\$10.00 per day/per family

Coach fee must be paid by parents before the first club night after the carnival, if fee is not paid, the swimmer will not be eligible to swim the club night. Proof of payment either by screenshot or remittance can be emailed to club – <u>collinsvilleswimclub@gmail.com</u> or sent to the swim club Facebook messenger.

Costs of running a swimming club includes registration of swimmers, club swimming attire, administration fees, travel costs for carnivals, trophies and medals for championships and home carnivals. With fundraising and grants, we strive to keep our fees as low as possible and family discounts may apply at times.

Parent Participation:

Good parent participation is an essential factor in the running of a "successful club".

Parents are encouraged to support and assist all club activities as much as possible. There are many ways to help: Attend meetings, working bees, fundraising, setting up and clearing away, volunteering at club nights, timekeepers, starter, referee, marshalling, cooking and many more small jobs. CSASC Club Rules:

1. Nominations for club night are done online via swim central.

Only enter 1 distance per stroke each club night. (eg. Either a distance of 33m or 200m)

- 2. Swimming club starts at 4.15pm.
- 3. Races will start at 4.30pm sharp, late nominations may be accepted (Subject to race secretary decision providing there is lane spaces). Late nominations to be paid by cash on the day.
- 4. Club officials only are permitted on the pool surround during races.
- 5. Swimmers under the age of 12 years old must be accompanied by an adult as per Council regulations.
- 6. Unsupervised swimmers under 18 years old will not be permitted to leave pool without parent/guardian consent. Unsupervised swimmers under 18 years old are considered the Swimming Club's responsibility, whilst at the pool during swimming club hours.
- 7. Any swimmer wishing to attend swimming meet/event, nominations are online through Swim Central.

<u>Club Championships: (2023/2024 season):</u> To be eligible for championship awards:

- 1. Presentations are held each year mid-late March.
- 2. You must be a registered financial member of our club.
- 3. You must have swum a third of eligible club nights in the season from date of membership.
- 4. Age group is determined by the swimmers age on the date of the last club night for the season.
- 5. This season, there will be no club championship event at the end of season. All events will be held throughout the season for Age Championship, Most Improved Points and Open events.
- 6. Age Championship will be awarded to the swimmer with the most overall points in their Age Group category. The most overall points for Age Championship will be tallied by using the swimmers fastest time for this season, for each stroke and allocated distance on age.
- Most improved points will accumulate throughout the season and will be tallied at the end of the season.
 <u>Age Groups and Distances each year are:</u>

7 & Under –33m Fr, Br, Bk & Fly & 132 IM 8 years –66m Fr, Br, Bk & Fly & 132 IM 9-10 years –66m Fr, Br, Bk & Fly & 132 IM 11-12 years –100m Fr, Br, Bk & Fly & 264IM 13-14 years –100m Fr, Br, Bk & Fly & 264IM 15-29 years –33m Fr, Br, Bk & Fly & 132 IM Open – 100m 200m 400m Free & 264 IM 1

- Open 100m, 200m, 400m Free & 264 IM, 100m Back, 100m Breast & 100m Fly
- 8. Open Distance events points are not counted towards age group aggregate. Qualifying times to participate.
- 9. Open trophy will be awarded to swimmer with the most overall points in Open category. To be eligible for points swimmers must swim the open event on the allocated club night. Swimmers that are unable to attend the club night for reason such as illness, injury or compassionate reasons (presented to the committee) are able to complete a make-up swim
- 10. All club rules have been adopted from Swimming Queensland.
- 11. Points system allocated for Age Championship, Open:
- 1st 7 points 2nd – 5 points 3rd – 3 points 4th and over – 1 point
